

In the current financial climate, the council will not be able to subsidise these routes indefinitely and that inevitably means people need to use their buses or lose them.



Somerset Council's Lead Member for Transport and Digital, Councillor Mike Rigby said:



"While we welcome the confirmation of continued funding from the government, it is less than grants which we've previously received ...

... and therefore we will have some tough decisions to make about use of the money.

It's really important that people continue to use bus services so we can make the money go further."

We'll be playing our part by continuing to improve reliability, helping our passengers get to where they need to be.








